TREASURER: \$143k in checking and \$73k in investments. Still need to do the transfer back into investments. Known invoices and expenses are up to date. Rob does have some expenses/deposits to make - will get them to Jen. Did receive divisional assessment invoice from NEDiv - check has been mailed.

MEMBERSHIP: Currently 260 members - down a few from last month. No new members since last meeting and a couple expired.

ACTIVITIES: Awards Banquet to be confirmed at the Y at Watson Woods in Painted Post on Jan 27, starting at noon until 3pm. Set to provide AV as needed and furnishings. Space is \$200/hr with 3 hour minimum. Catering menu yet to be decided - estimated to be around \$16-20 per person.

WEBSITE: Still has been stable, no issues observed for quite a while.

CLUB RACING: Dates reviewed in last meeting. Still no contracts from WGI. Expect to have them in the next month or two. FV Challenge planning to come back for Sprints next year. SRFs interested in potentially having their own group - will be discussions about some minimum number to make that happen.
