REport:

Glen Region Members,

There have been some changes to the National Racing Schedule in the division for 2010 and 2011. A new group to coordinate the NESCCA Series of National Races was approved by the Regions of NeDiv. This group is called the National Racing Committee (NRC) and is made up of the REs (or their designates) of the regions hosting a national race. This group is tasked to coordinate the national racing schedule in the division, the budget of the NESCCA Series, and end of year awards. Also this group completes their work and then makes 'a group' recommendation on all items to the NeDiv Council of REs in the division for various required voting.

At the RoundTable held on March 12-14th, this group including myself, spent a total of over 5 hours meeting in a closed room. After much discussion, learning of each other needs, plans for the future, and statistics showing what the entrant drivers want, it was decided that in 2010 (this year) there would be one Double National event and it is to be held at WGI, hosted by the Glen Region on July 9-11th (Fri-Sun). All other 2010 National Races will be single events. In 2011, it was decided that (at this point in time...it could change at the next meeting of the NRC) there would be a Double National at WGI hosted by the FingerLakes Region, and one other Double National that would rotate around the division. The NRC will meet next in person at the Glen National in July.

The purpose of making the Glen National into a Double is to create a 'Divisional Signature Event', much like the June Sprints are at Road America. Therefore, the event shall be not only for the purpose of the Glen Region hosting a national, but also for the divisions to grow the NeDiv national racing program. There will be support from NESCCA for items such as advertising, promotion, etc. The event will also 'give back' to the division in ways such as assessment fees, etc. These are being worked out and will be in place once we have the events budget set.

It goes without saying that this event is going to be HUGE. We have been setting up an event committee. If you are interested in assisting in the success of this event, please let me or Larry Emery know ASAP. We will be looking for help on the committee in areas such as worker gifts, party, social, non-race social (off sight events), and more. This event will be more than just a Double National. It will be an "event"! Does anyone know of someone in the business of carnival rides?

Please pass the word that "the double at the Glen National is on for 2010"! And feel free to reply to me with any and all questions. --Ed...

NEDiv National Race discussion. Ongoing discussion regarding national/double national events in the division. Have been taking changes/suggestions. Will be presented at Roundtable.

New membership programs from National office. Worker benefits, family membership changes, etc.

Green Grand Prix: Idea proposed to have student "reporters" at GGP in 2010. Videos will be edited and shared with area schools. GGP is requesting \$500 donation to purchase 4 Flip video cameras for the students to use.

MOTION: Larry, 2nd Tim: Donate \$500 to GGP for purchase of 4 Flip video cameras. CARRIED.

WGI Opening Weekend: Chance of opening weekend car corral "group thing" this year. Will decline that this year – but may do IRL weekend again.

2010 Sponsorship: Sunoco is sponsoring some west coast races. Chance of similar deal for WGI events. Would need to find/appoint some sort of "administrative" person to run it. Will get details.
