Motion by Cheryl, second by Sandy: Accept January minutes as presented with spelling corrections and changes to MARRS info. Carried.

Calendar Committee: Comprised of Activities Director, CRB Chair, Solo Chair and Rally Chair to submit proposed schedule to BoD by 3/1. Kind of already do this.

Received a thank you letter from WG library for our recent donation. Letter from Treasury: We will retain tax exempt status but did have some [minor] deficiencies.

Treasurer's Report: Currently \$73K in checking and about \$82K in investments. Still have \$4600 to pay for the van –question again if we want to pay it off or not-to think about. May event update: Registrars are okay with charging registration fees a bit earlier than normal-but still working out the best timing. **Motion**: Phil, 2nd Dave: Accept Treasurer's report as presented. Carried.

The 2012 Glen Region Solo season might be best considered as a "back to basics" season. We are back at a core of traditional venues, and are in the process of building up and training an expanded corps of volunteers to keep our events running smoothly. In particular, we really need to provide relief to our Solo Safety Stewards, and are always looking for willing Event Chairs.

Unfortunately, one venue missing this season is Seneca Army Depot (SeAD). Last year's trial of an additional payment per driver to assist the site owner (Seneca County Industrial Development Agency) was a good-faith effort, but in the end it wasn't sufficient to meet SCIDA's needs. The Finger Lakes Region took the lead in this year's negotiations, and their effort is much appreciated. SeAD is a potentially regionally (in the geographic sense) important site, and hopefully negotiations in 2013 can reach a more favorable conclusion.

On a positive note, we've maintained strong connections with our other host sites, including the Arnot Mall, Corning Community College, The Shops at Ithaca Mall and Watkins Glen International. On May 19th we will return to the Murray Athletic Facility (a.k.a. The Domes) in Horseheads for the annual Solo School. Do you know of anyone with an interest in motorsports but who has hesitated to participate in the past because they don't have a "real" racecar? Send them our way ... the Solo School is a great introduction not only Solo events, but also the Glen Region and the SCCA in general. I know that as a graduate I was surprised by how much fun I could have in my daily driver (when I wasn't collecting cones)!

Back in March, a crew of Solo participants travelled to the divisional Roundtable event in Pocono Mountain, PA, and many of us came back excited about the possibility of adding at least one RallyCross event to our season. The Solo season still ends on October 7th at Watkins Glen International, but on October 21st we will be back at Black Rock Speedway in Dundee NY for a RallyCross event after several years' absence. Cones, dirt and limited traction surfaces ... it should be a blast.

Please check the Glen Region website for schedule updates. We have a full schedule of eight events, not including the school and the October 21st RallyCross. Glen Region Solo events have a reputation as being safe, competitive and friendly, and we aim to keep it that way in 2012. Hope you can join us!

However, the people creating tapes (and lap charts) are actually the primary system during the race. That's the scoring side. But enough of the technical details, I would like to extend an invitation to anyone even remotely interested in cars to give T&S a try. You, the reader, are a member of the Sports Car Club of America; I think you might have the interested in cars part down. I will make sure you get paired with someone who has some experience for your few sessions working and rotate through all the different areas to see what you like to do best. We have all sorts of good snacks, friendly people and a temperature controlled room. This is especially nice for rainy days, or cold October mornings during the Last Chance. You don't need to commit for a full day, but come visit the T&S room in the tower during any race this season.
