CALL TO ORDER: 7:00 pm

MOTION: Kyle, Chuck: Accept March minutes as presented. CARRIED

CORRESPONDENCE: Received a packet from a local photographer. Appears to try to advertise for his photography business - hard to tell. Also received notice from NY state about searching for unclaimed funds through the state - will pass to Greg.

TREASURER: Checking has \$11k, investment account has \$103k, Meddaugh investments has \$393k.

MEMBERSHIP: 261 with 6 new and 8 expired at this moment.

GREEN GRAND PRIX: CCC tech students brought Tim's Fiero to the event. Overall good day for the event and the weather worked out well. PA system used for the driver's meeting seemed to work better than past years. Toyota sponsors were very pleased with the event. Road rally ran the long course again and almost everyone behaved well. Had 44 entries in the road rally and 38 entries in the autocross (with likely a LOT more drivers). All entries split between various types of propulsion (electric, hybrid, modified, etc). Had 10 different colleges and universities represented. MCC came to spectate again this year and will attempt to attend with a vehicle to participate next year. BAE Systems brought electric and hybrid modular trucks to show off and do laps around the track. Gave out 22 awards and \$4500 in cash prizes/starting money. Williams Auto Group gave out 3 of their own special trophies. Next year will work to improve autocross data entry (need make, model, color, number, school, etc). Have decided to have Glen Region pay sanction/audit fees and the GGP will reimburse (easiest way to transact). WGI president came to watch the autocross and Ed was able to have some good discussion and relationship building with her. Also did have some local news coverage from a local FOX affiliate.

CLUB RACING: Sprints event coming up next weekend. Time Trials contact had initially estimated about 30 TT entries and we are around 36 at the moment. Road Racing entries around 87 but still a couple weeks to go. Cost per minute between TT and racing is roughly the same with TT being slightly more expensive with more track time. TT will not have novice groups - only intermediate and advanced groups.

SOLO: Have put together a schedule for 2026. First event was an out of region with SNY last weekend at the Binghamton airport - with had 41 entries. Will end up with a few more OOR events this year compared to past. Otherwise will be alternating CCC, Arnot Mall, and WGI Media Lot with two of each. Will need to get events added to MSR - Rob wants to make some changes and will get with Allan to finish it up. Also have an idea to have some "trophy" decals made for finishing positions like our old trophies. These would be generic and used year to year and FAR cheaper than any of the other trophies we previously used. Van will need to be inspected soon - also may be making a new knocking sound when cold. Have inquired previously and told bearings and everything are OK, but just trying to catch something before it fails, if it does.

SUBCOMMITTEES: No update.

MOTION: Chuck, Kyle: Look into options to replace RE laptop and purchase at a cost of up to \$1700. CARRIED.

RE LAPTOP: Allan will investigate options to replace RE laptop. Now has two broken hinges and is being held together by literal tape.
